Morehouse School of Medicine...

- Was founded in 1975 as the Medical Education Program at Morehouse College; and in 1981 Morehouse School of Medicine (MSM) became an independently chartered institution and the first medical school established at a Historically Black College and University in the 20th century.
- Is a member of the Atlanta University Center Consortium comprised of four independent institutions, making it the largest Historically Black educational complex in the nation. Other member institutions include: Clark Atlanta University, Morehouse College and Spelman College.
- Is a recipient of the highly coveted National Institutes of Health Clinical and Translational Science awards (CTSAs), partnering with Emory University and Georgia Institute of Technology. The national consortium is transforming how clinical and translational research is conducted, ultimately enabling researchers to provide new treatments more efficiently to patients.
- Employs more than 200 full- and part-time faculty members, many of whom are internationally recognized in their fields. Among its faculty, leadership and alumni, MSM has five members elected to the prestigious Institute of Medicine.
- Has seen its research stature and reputation grow exponentially over the last decade, fueled in large part by significant investments in the research infrastructure with funding from the National Institutes of Health (NIH), American Heart Association, Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), the Georgia Cancer Coalition and others.
- Secured 135 research-related grants totaling more than \$63 million in FY2010 with the total economic impact of MSM's research-related activities being \$52.9 million supporting more than 2,300 jobs in Georgia.

- Ranks number one of all medical schools in the country on our social mission based on a study published in the Annals of Internal Medicine.
- > Has established centers, institutes and programs with signature areas of research being cardio-metabolic diseases, cancer, HIV/AIDS, and other infectious diseases, and neurological disorders - all areas that disproportionately impact minority communities.
- Has seven residency programs: Family Medicine, Public Health and General Preventive Medicine, Internal Medicine, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Psychiatry, Surgery, and Pediatrics.
- Confers the Doctor of Medicine, Doctor of Philosophy in Biomedical Sciences, Master of Public Health, Master of Science in Clinical Research, Master of Science in Biomedical Research and Master of Science in Biomedical Technology degrees.
- > Has nearly 100 practicing physicians affiliated with the faculty practice plan, Morehouse Medical Associates, making it one of the largest physician groups in Georgia and one of the state's premier primary care and multispecialty medical practices.
- Has organized the Community Physicians' network, housed in MSM's Clinical Research Center, which has been recognized by the AAMC as a "best practice" in academic community partnerships.
- Is home to the National Center for Primary Care that serves as a national resource in promoting the value of primary care medicine and encouraging doctors to pursue primary care careers. It conducts practice-based research to improve health outcomes; creates protocols and tools for improving primary care effectiveness; and undertakes public policy analyses focused on making primary care services more accessible and effective.
